.....Sept 30th is the deadline to apply for Michigan’s Home Heating Credit in 2011. The form may be obtained from the Dept. of Treasury’s website-Michigan.gov/taxes or by calling 517-636-4486. To be eligible, you must own or rent the home in which you live and your income must fall between certain limits-Maximum Income for 1=\$11,929, for 2=\$16,043, for 3=\$20,158, for 4= \$24,272, for 5=\$28,387, for 6=\$32,500. IF mailing, must be postmarked by Sept 30th.
