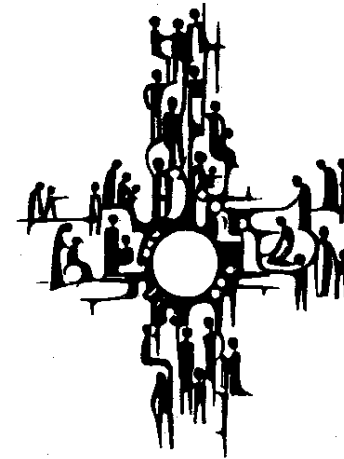

These Detroit Area hospitals will be conducting an emergency seizure study, enrolling patients who are actively seizing despite initial treatment. Any person over the age of 2 may be eligible and will receive one of three commonly used medications to stop the seizure. We will be hosting a community consultation **after Mass TODAY at 12:00pm in the Parlor in the Activities Building** to provide information, answer questions and get community members' thoughts and feelings about the study.
