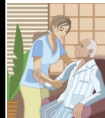

6. Although she was born in New Orleans and brought up in California, this famous soprano/mezzo-soprano taught at the University of Michigan and lived in Ann Arbor from 1996 until her death last November.
7. In 1925, a black gynecologist moved with his family into a white neighborhood on Garland Street, on Detroit's east side. A white mob assembled outside the house and shots were fired from within, killing one man and wounding another. Defended by noted lawyer Clarence Darrow, the doctor was acquitted. What was his name?
8. Although this famous inventor was born in Canada in the 1840's, he lived in Detroit (on Lincoln Avenue) and is buried in Warren. Name him.
9. Martin Luther King Jr. visited Detroit in 1963, delivering an early version of his "I Have a Dream" speech at Cobo Hall. Five years later (and three weeks before he was assassinated), he spoke at a high school in a Detroit suburb. Which school was it?
