.....Our St. Vincent de Paul Conference needs people to help make home visits to people seeking help. If you are able, please confer with Fr. Thomas.

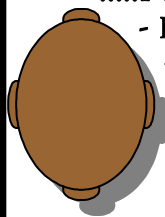

BLACK HISTORY MONTH QUIZ

1. Born in the Dominican Republic, he was the first black ballplayer for the Detroit Tigers. In his home debut as a Tiger, on June 17, 1958, he batted five for five.
2. Because blacks were often denied treatment at Detroit's medical institutions, this hospital organized by a group of 30 African-Americans doctors, opened its doors in 1918 in a home on Frederick Street, which still stands today. Name it.
3. The Marvelettes, the Motown girl group from Inkster, rejected this Holland-Dozier-Holland song, so the Supremes recorded it in 1964, scoring their first No. 1 hit. What was the song?
4. In 1957, he became the first African-American elected to the Detroit City Council.
5. In 1972, she was the first African-American woman elected to the Detroit City Council.
