Palm Sunday, today is the beginning of Holy Week. Palms will be blessed and given at all Masses. The Palm celebrates Jesus exciting trip to Jerusalem that eventually led to his crucifixion. We keep the blessed palm to remind us of our relationship with Jesus: His teaching, His living, His giving, His dying and His rising to be with us now.

**Tuesday** in Holy Week has the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Sacrament of Penance) as part of the 6 p.m. Mass— an opportunity to repent and redirect ourselves with the promise of God's Spirit to make it happen.

**Thursday** in Holy week at 6 p.m. is the Holy Thursday celebration of Jesus giving himself in the Holy Eucharist at His Last Supper. We recall the Washing of the feet and make our Communion with Jesus. Ministers of Service, Ministers of Faith, and Religious Brothers and Sisters renew our commitment to service.

.....**Good Friday's Service on April 22nd begins at 12 noon** as Jesus' death on the Cross is remembered in the Stations of the Cross, the Prayers for all People, the Veneration of the Cross, and Receiving Holy Communion.
